March 12: Feathered Friends. Observe the characteristics and feeding habits of winter birds in Ontario.

March 13: Wild Edibles. Campers will learn how to identify and forage for wild edible and medicinal plants and learn how to tap trees for maple syrup.

March 14: Winter Wildlife. Not all animals hibernate or migrate. Campers will be able to explore different habitats, and explore what animals are active in the winter.

March 15: Wilderness Survival. Learn some basic survival skills for the outdoors; orienteering and how to build a fire and shelter.
