

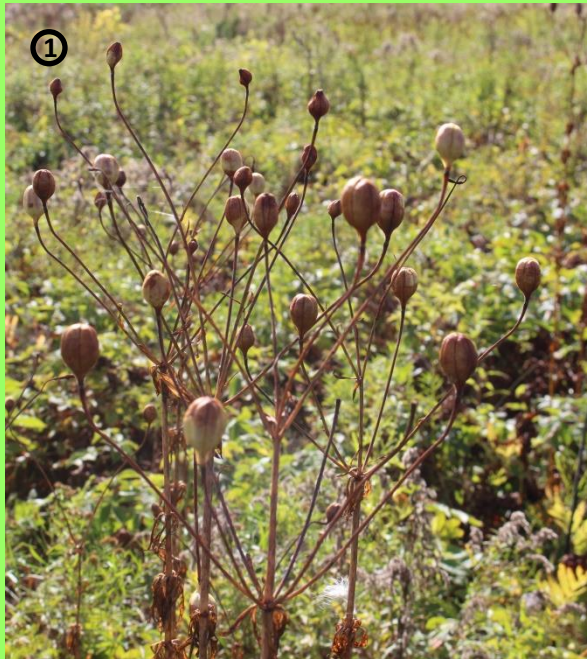


Cooper Marsh Nursery & Wildlife Garden
